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Three Fatal Errors Common Among False Teachers

ince we are now living in the age of religious tolerance and ecumenical unity, there are some people who will immediately call this article unloving and divisive. Others will ask "What right do you have to judge another religion?" The answer is given in Scripture. All God-fearing people are called to make right judgments, judgments that have already been established by the objective principles of God's word (John 7:24). There may be nothing more important than warning people who are being deceived about their eternal destiny. If we do not lovingly confront them with God's Gospel, they may never know how to escape the eternal fire of God's punishment. Clearly, the most unloving thing we can do is to ignore them and let them continue down the road to destruction. For this reason, I am always willing to offend people with the offense and exclusivity of the Gospel in the hopes that God may grant some of them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth (2 Tim. 2: 25). Let us look at three fatal errors of false prophets and how to handle them.

False Teachers Usurp the Authority of God

The supreme authority of the Bible is established both by its divine origin and inspiration (2 Pet. 1:21). It is the infallible word of God and it will accomplish God's purpose (Isaiah 55:11). It is the very foundation upon which all Christian truths rest. For followers of the Lord Jesus Christ, the Bible is the final court of appeal in all matters pertaining to faith and godliness. "All Scripture is Godbreathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness" (2 Tim. 3:15). The divine authority of Scripture corrects and rebukes all false teaching because there is no higher authority or infallible source in which to appeal. It is the Word

of God who cannot lie, cannot break His promise and cannot deceive.

People fall into serious error and sin when they exalt their own authority over God's authority or when they suppress the truth of God's word to promote their own selfserving agendas. The Roman Catholic religion has done this by establishing its traditions and teachings to be equal in authority with Scripture (Catechism of the Catholic Church [CCC] para. 82). In doing so, they have usurped the supreme authority of our sovereign God who alone has the right to rule and determine the eternal destinies of men. This fatal error has opened the flood gates to numerous other deadly heresies including: the preaching of another gospel, the worship of a counterfeit Jesus, the buying and selling of God's grace through indulgences, the creation of a fictitious place called purgatory, the establishment of other mediators and praying to and for the dead. These errors are fatal because anyone who is embracing them when they take their last breath will experience eternal death.

Catholics who are being deceived by these fatal errors must be told that the world has known only one infallible teacher. He is the Lord Jesus Christ, who was the personification of truth and every word He spoke was truth (John 14:6, 17:17). Those who are seeking the truth need to look only to Christ and His Word. The Catholic religion has become corrupt the same way Judaism became corrupt - by following the traditions of men instead of the Word of God (Mark 7:13). The Pharisees taught much truth, but by mixing it with error that they "made the word of God of no effect." We must never forget that

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the Bible is what God says and religion is what *man says* God says.

False Teachers Distort the Person of Christ

Jesus Christ is God's perfect man and man's perfect God. He is the perfect High Priest who offered Himself - the perfect sacrifice - once for the sins of His people. This one sin offering has perfected for all time those who are sanctified (Heb. 10:14). For this reason there are no more offerings for sin (Heb. 10:18). The believer's eternal sin debt was paid in full and their redemption was secured when God raised Jesus Christ from the dead (Rom. 4:25). Would there be false teachers who would deny this and steal away the honor and glory of our Savior?

Yes, Paul even warned us that some would come preaching another Jesus. They will offer a counterfeit Jesus "whom we [the apostles] have not preached" (2 Cor. 11:4). Many of these false teachers are Roman Catholics who preach a "Jesus" who does not save sinners completely and forever. They say Catholics must do their part by expiating and making satisfaction for the own sins through penance (CCC, 1459). In this way they attain their own salvation through good works (CCC, 1477). The Catholic Jesus offers conditional life, not eternal life (CCC, 1035). This counterfeit Christ is said to return physically to Catholic altars over 200,000 times each day to be a sin offering for the living and the dead.

Catholics must be warned of the consequences for not knowing and believing the true Jesus. This was made this clear by Jesus when He said: "unless you believe that I am He, you shall die in your sins" (John 8:24). Whenever religion rejects God's authority, it creates "another Jesus" which always leads to "another gospel." Why? Because whenever the sufficiency of Christ is denied, another gospel must be concocted to instruct people what they must do to be saved.

False Teachers Pervert the Gospel of Christ

The Gospel is the joyous proclamation of God's redeeming work through Jesus Christ which saves His people from the punishment, power and ultimately, the presence of sin. It is the one and only message of redemption and the same message for every generation (Eph. 4:4-6, Rev. 14:6). Since the Gospel is about one Savior, it is exclusive and thus declares that all other faiths and religions are false (John 14:6; Mat. 7:13-14). This glo-

rious Gospel declares that salvation is entirely of grace and those who add anything to it stand condemned (Gal. 1:6-9). It comes as no surprise that the most popular perversion of the Gospel is the fatal lie that good works are necessary to appease a holy and righteous God. Every religion in the world has perpetrated this lie of the devil. His oldest and most deadly lie is coupled with that one. "If you are good enough, "'You surely shall not die'" (Gen. 3:4).

Why would any religious leader want to distort the glorious Gospel of grace? The primary reason is to control people by holding them captive in legalistic bondage. It is for this reason the Lord Jesus gave the mark of a true disciple. He said, "If you abide in My word...and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:31-32). People in religious bondage can only be set free when they come to a knowledge of the truth found in Scripture.

Roman Catholicism is not alone in perverting the Gospel of God. There are many cults and Protestant sects which do the same. Catholicism, however, not only deceives its people with a false gospel, but foolishly condemns those who believe the true Gospel. Over 100 condemnations from Catholic councils are pronounced on Christians who believe the Lord Jesus is sufficient to save sinners completely and forever. The Catholic "gospel" emphasizes what man must DO to be saved instead of what Christ has DONE. This would include the necessity of doing good works (CCC, 2016), receiving sacraments (1129), attending meritorious masses (1405), keeping the law (2068), buying indulgences (1498) and purgatory (1030).

False Teachers Must Be Confronted

We must never let doctrinal error go unabated because it dishonors God and deceives the unsuspecting. It defiles the conscience, corrupts the heart and destroys the soul. According to Scripture that which flows from the lips of false teachers includes: "strange doctrines," "commandments of men," "doctrines of devils," "damnable heresies," "traditions of men," "lies," "falsehood," "vain deceit" and "deceptive philosophy." Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord at all times and in all cases (Prov. 12:22). Knowing the fruit of false teachers we must earnestly contend against them. Peter and Paul said false teachers cause believers to fall from their steadfastness and pure devo-

Born-Again Catholics?

More and more Christians are telling us they are meeting "born-again Catholics." When we ask them how do you know they are born-again, their response goes something like this. "Well, they really love Jesus" or "they are so sincere in their faith." If they really loved the true Jesus they would obey His word and "flee from idolatry" (1 Cor. 10:14; 1 John 4:3). Furthermore, if Jesus were the only object of their faith they would renounce the religion that deceives a billion people with a false gospel. Catholics who have repented and believed the true Gospel will be led by the Holy Spirit out of Catholicism's spiritual darkness into the glorious light of Jesus. If they do not come out by the Spirit's prompting, they will soon be asked to leave by the priests. Why? Because no priest would want anyone in their church proclaiming the true Gospel and setting other Catholics free.

What would Paul say to these so-called born-again Catholics? The same thing he tells any professing Christian: "you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart...be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and...put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness" (Eph. 4:17-24). God's word leaves no middle ground!

You cannot find any of the following Catholic traditions in the church of the apostles: priests offering sacrifices for sin, purgatory, indulgences, infallible popes, or Mary as a sinless mediatrix, etc. By the way it was God who determined the canon and which authors He would inspire to write the Scriptures (2 Pet. 1:21). I wanted to give you a briefing on our witnessing efforts during the Pope's visit to Washington, D.C. We took a team of six to the stadium and handed out 5,000 of your tracts to the throngs of people entering. We had a few people tell us how wrong we were to try to lead people out of the Roman Catholic church. One fellow told us our efforts were very "disingenuous," and a couple of people persuaded us to return to the "mother church." We had opportunities to clarify the meaning of certain passages of Scripture like Matthew 16:18-19 (the rock upon which the church is built) and James 2:17 (dead faith contrasted with genuine faith). Our goal is to send them to one of the few "Bible-driven" churches in our area. As I speak in various churches I am observing the growing apostasy of the church. When Rick Warren started promoting his Purpose Driven Life, I knew we were headed for tough times. 
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Pope's Life Was A Sign of Christ's Resurrection

A memorial Mass was held April 2 in honor of Pope John Paul II, whose abiding memory continues to draw thousands of visitors every day to his tomb inside St. Peter's Basilica. Pope Benedict said that the life and pontificate, was as a whole and in many specific moments, "a sign and witness of the Resurrection of Christ." He said, "Indeed, we can read the entire life of my beloved predecessor, in particular his Petrine ministry, as a sign of the Risen Christ." Benedict XVI said, "His agony was beheld by all this day." Benedict continued to explain by saying, Pope John Paul decided to carry his cross together with Jesus, following in his footsteps. He did all of this through the unique mediation of Mary, Mother of the Church. Pope John Paul II's conformity to Christ lasted until the end of his life...the final sacrifice, the gift of self. John Paul II conformed himself to Christ, even physically, in the case of suffering and the complete confident abandonment in the arms of the Heavenly Father. (CNA, 4/2/2008)

Padre Pio's Body Exhumed for Veneration

The body of St Padre Pio, one of Italy's most popular saints, was exhumed for public veneration marking the 40th anniversary of his death and the 90th anniversary of the first appearance of stigmata on his hands and feet. Capuchin friars at the sanctuary where Padre Pio's tomb is visited by seven million pilgrims annually, said that "parts of the body" had been found to be "intact." The Archbishop said the body was in "surprisingly good condition. As soon as we got inside the tomb we could clearly make out the beard...the chin is perfect and the rest of the body is well preserved. The knees, hands, mittens and nails are clearly visible.

If Padre Pio allows me, I might say he looks as though he just had a manicure". The body is now in a glass covered coffin for veneration for several months. The exhumation was approved by the Vatican and the first time the tomb had been opened since Padre Pio's death in 1968. An Archbishop said the friar's body had been exhumed "to check on its state and to carry out all the necessary work to guarantee the best conditions for its conservation." Pope John XXIII, who died in 1963, had also been exhumed when he was beatified, the step before sainthood. The body was found to be unusually well preserved. An Italian historian, Sergio Luzzatto, recently caused controversy with a book on Padre Pio in which he claimed to have found documents in the Vatican archives suggesting that Padre Pio may have faked his stigmata, the marks of the wounds of Christ, with acid, and also had "intimate and incorrect relations with women". Followers of Padre Pio believe he had the gift of bilocation (being in two places at once), healed the sick and could prophesy the future. (TimesOnLine, 3/3/08)

New Indulgence Granted

Benedict XVI will grant a plenary indulgence on the two-thousandth anniversary of the birth of St. Paul. Plenary indulgences remove all temporal punishments that afflict people as a result of their sins. The decree states that the Holy Father is granting the indulgences to provide the faithful with "spiritual treasures for their own sanctification" in honor of St. Paul. The faithful must "undertake a pious visit in the form of a pilgrimage to the papal basilica of St. Paul on Rome's Via Ostiense and pray in accordance with the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff" to be "granted and imparted Plenary Indulgence for the temporal punishment of their sins. Each person may obtain an indulgence for themselves or for anyone who is deceased

"as many times as the aforementioned acts are undertaken; however, a Plenary Indulgence may be obtained only once a day." (CNA, 5/12/2008)

Islam Overtakes Catholicism

Islam has overtaken Roman Catholicism as the biggest religion in the world. The Vatican's newly-released 2008 yearbook of statistics, said Muslims made up 19.2 percent of the world's population and Catholics 17.4 percent. "For the first time in history we are no longer at the top: the Muslims have overtaken us," according to a Vatican official. If all Christian groups were considered, including Orthodox churches, Anglicans and Protestants, then Christians made up 33 percent of the world's population -- or about 2 billion people. The Vatican recently put the number of Catholics in the world at 1.13 billion people. It did not provide a figure for Muslims, generally estimated at around 1.3 billion. The percentage of Muslims was growing faster because of higher birth rates. (Reuters, 3/30/08)

Divine Mercy is Key to Catholic-Mulsim Dialogue

The rediscovery of divine mercy is key for interreligious dialogue, contended Cardinal Philippe Barbarin of France. Mercy is a "theme of primary importance in dialogue with Muslims." He said, "It is impressive to see that among the 99 divine names, the most used are precisely 'the Very Merciful' and the 'All-Merciful', always attributed to Allah." The Cardinal said, "These two names are repeated twice in the Fatiha which Muslims repeat 17 times every day during his five daily prayers." He stated, "We confirm that the notion of tolerance, ceaselessly used intentionally in interreligious dialogue, does not mean much; we must move from tolerance to mutual esteem, and if the Lord gives us the grace, to admiration." Pope Prays for Unity With Armenian Apostolic Church

The Holy Father met with His Holiness Karekin II, the Patriarch of Armenian Apostolic Church and a group of 75 Armenian faithful and 18 bishops to celebrate Midday Prayer. The Pope spoke about the importance of striving for Christian unity. He prayed that ecumenical dialogue "will bring us closer to full and visible communion, and that the day will come when our unity in faith makes possible a common celebration of the Eucharist." Roman Catholicism's Fatal Fascination with "Another Mary"

Knowing the wiles of the devil, the apostle Paul exhorts us to be purely devoted to Jesus Christ. He wrote: "just as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds should be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ" (2 Cor. 11:3). In Roman Catholicism, there are many diversions that lead Catholics away from Christ, but none so prevalent as their perversion of the biblical Mary. Following are some of their recent apostate activities relating to the "Catholic Mary".

Glorification of Mary through a Fifth Marian Dogma

An antidote to the challenges facing the Church and society today is the glorification of Mary through the proclamation of a fifth Marian dogma, says Cardinal Vithayathil of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church in India. The Church is made up of about 3.5 million of India's 16 million Catholics. Cardinal Vithayathil, is one of the five cardinals who sent a letter in January inviting prelates worldwide to join them in petitioning Benedict XVI to declare a fifth Marian dogma they said would "proclaim the full Christian truth about Mary." The petition asks the Pope to proclaim Mary as "the Spiritual Mother of All Humanity, the co-redemptrix with Jesus the redeemer, mediatrix of all graces and advocate with Jesus Christ on behalf of the human race." In the following interview, Cardinal Vithayathil comments on the effect the proclamation of the dogma could have on interreligious and ecumenical dialogue.

Q: Do Syro-Malabar Catholics have a particularly generous devotion to Our Lady?

Cardinal: Yes, we have a great tradition of intense devotion to Our Lady. There is a belief among us that the apostle St. Thomas, who first preached the Gospel to their ancestors, had brought with him a replica of the picture of the Blessed Virgin supposedly painted by the Evangelist Luke. Centuries before the Portuguese missionaries arrived, there were many churches dedicated to Our Lady in Malabar.

Pope John Paul II has asserted that the Syro-Malabar Catholics were never formally separated from the Sea of St. Peter during the 20 centuries of their existence. During the three centuries that the Latin Carmelite bishops from Europe ruled the Syro-Malabar Church,

there was a deepening of devotion to Our Lady. Practically every member of the community wore the brown Carmelite scapular and recited the family rosary everyday. I believe this Marian devotion is the reason why 70% of all missionaries in India are from this Church and why this Church ordains 250 priests every year.

Q: Why do you think the time is opportune for the declaration of a fifth Marian dogma?

Cardinal: Through private revelations at Lourdes and Fatima, Mary has made known that God wishes, as an antidote to the sad situations of the world today, the glorification of his mother through the recitation of the holy rosary and devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The fifth Marian dogma would certainly improve the world situation through the prayers of Mary to her divine Son. Many believe that the danger of Marxist Communism was averted by the apparitions of Mary at Lourdes and Fatima and the consequent increase in devotion to Mary.

Q: Do you think this Marian dogma would hurt the ecumenical cause for the Church?

Cardinal: Not only will it never hurt the ecumenical movement, but it will positively enhance it. I feel that it is God's will that we should honor Our Lady in a special way at this juncture of world history. Only good can come out of doing God's will. The Hindu communities in India are extremely open to the concept of "Mother," and they enthusiastically participate in the Marian devotions of the Catholic Church. The Orthodox Churches with whom we live together, already believe in this doctrine. It may sour Catholic-Protestant relations, but Our Lady knows how to heal this. An infallible definition by the Pope will help deepen the confidence of the people of God in Mary's role as co-redemptrix, mediatrix of all graces and advocate. (Zenit 5/21/08)

Pope Calls Catholics to Trust Mary

At a meeting with young people in the northern Italian city of Savona, Pope Benedict XVI invited them to trust in Mary. He recalled the words Mary spoke to shepherd Benedict Pareto in the year 1400 urging him to build a shrine at the place where she appeared. Pareto was worried because he did not know

how to respond to Mary's invitation. The Pope repeated the Virgin Mary's words to him: "trust in me! With me in your midst you will not fail. With my help everything will be easy. Only keep your will firm. Trust in me!"

"Mary repeats this to us today," Pope Benedict said. "An ancient prayer, very dear in popular tradition, makes us turn in confidence to You with these confident words, that today we make our own: 'Remember, O Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, sought your help or implored your intercession was left abandoned.' It is with this certainty that we invoke the motherly care of Our Lady of the Guard on your community." (CNA, 5/18/08)

A New Prayer to Mary

Pope Benedict composed a prayer to Our Lady of Sheshan to celebrate the Day of Prayer for the Church in China. The pope expressed his hope that May 24, the memorial of Our Lady Help of Christians, who is venerated at the shrine of Seshan in Shanghai, would become a day of prayer. The text of the pope's prayer follows:

"Virgin Most Holy, Mother of the Incarnate Word and our Mother, venerated in the Shrine of Sheshan under the title 'Help of Christians,' the entire Church in China looks to you with devout affection. We come before you today to implore your protection. Look upon the People of God and, with a mother's care, guide them along the paths of truth and love, so that they may always be a leaven of harmonious coexistence among all citizens. When you obediently said 'yes' in the house of Nazareth, you allowed God's eternal Son to take flesh in your virginal womb and thus to begin in history the work of our redemption. You willingly and generously co-operated in that work, allowing the sword of pain to pierce your soul, until the supreme hour of the Cross, when you kept watch on Calvary, standing beside your Son, who died that we might live. Our Lady of Sheshan, sustain all those in China, who, amid their daily trails, continue to believe, to hope, to love. In the statue overlooking the Shrine you lift your Son on high, offering him to the world with open arms in a gesture of love. Help Catholics always to be credible witnesses to this love, ever clinging to the rock of Peter on which the Church is built. Mother of China and all Asia, pray for us, now and for ever. Amen! "

tion to Christ (2 Pet. 3:17; 2 Cor. 11:3). They disagree with the words of Jesus and bring constant friction within the church (1 Tim. 6:4-5). They give rise to speculation and fruitless discussion which hinder the purposes of God (1 Tim. 1:4-6).

Many who profess Christ are no longer embracing sound doctrine because they want their ears tickled and are seeking teachers who will do just that (2 Tim. 4:2). Using the Word of God we must be ready to reprove, rebuke and exhort with great patience and instruction. Those who have been entrusted with the truth must take a stand against those who try to lead men astray. Even when Peter was not straightforward about the truth of the Gospel, Paul withstood him to the face, and rebuked him sharply (Gal. 2:11-14). Jude exhorted us to "earnestly contend for the faith once delivered to the saints" (Jude 3). Those who refuse to defend God's truth are demonstrating their lack of passion for the truth. We must love the truth and hate every false way (Ps. 119:104). Let us never be intimidated by false teachers because "the fear of man brings a snare" (Prov. 29:25).

The Battle for Truth

Let us be mindful of the words of A.W. Tozer who wrote: "So skilled is error at imitating truth that the two are constantly being mistaken for each other. It is therefore critically important that the Christian take full advantage of every provision God has made to save him from delusion - prayer, faith, constant meditation of the Scriptures, obedience, humility and the illumination of the Holy Spirit" (That Incredible Christian).

We need to ask God for courage and boldness as we rely on the power of His Word. May we all become more like the apostles who were strong, bold, fearless, dogmatic, unaccommodating of error, courageous, intolerant of sin, inflexible concerning the Gospel, controversial, willing to die for the truth and fully devoted to Christ. We are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves, and carried about by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming (Eph. 4:14). During these times of great deception the Body of Christ must respond with a theological, biblical worldview that defends the glory and honor of our Lord Jesus Christ. We must protect the purity of His Gospel for the sake of His elect.
